^{*}This course fulfills both a TSU Core area and Sociology degree requirement. If this TSU Core area is completed with a course other than the listed course, the listed course may have to be completed in one of the course slots designated "elective or minor course".

***The Sociology degree requires students to complete both SOCI 4303 and SOCI 4399. Students will complete one of these two courses in the fall semester and the other course in the spring semester.

****The Sociology degree requires students to complete either an eighteen hour set of elective courses or an eighteen hour minor. For both the set of elective courses and the minor at least six of the required eighteen hours be advanced. If the student has already completed at least three hours of their elective or minor advanced minor coursework they may take a lower or advanced level minor course in this slot.

^{**}The Sociology degree requires students to complete either PHIL 1301 or PHIL 2303. PHIL 1301 will also satisfy the TSU Core: Language, Philosophy, and Culture requirement. So students who complete PHIL 1301 can take an additional elective course in place of the TSU Core: Language, Philosophy, and Culture requirement listed in the third year. Those students who completed PHIL 2303 must still complete the TSU Core: Language, Philosophy, and Culture listed in the third year.

Degree Information

- This 120 hour four-year degree plan provides a model for on-time completion of this TSU program using as many TCCNS courses as possible. The four-year plan also shows the first point when no TCCNS options are available for this program. See the current Undergraduate Catalog for course prerequisites. Course availability at TSU is subject to change, and the plan shown below may change based on updates to TSU's course offerings.
- Texas Common Course Numbering System (TCCNS) provides a shared, uniform set of course designations for students and their advisors to use in determining both course equivalency and degree applicability of transfer credit on a statewide basis.
- <u>Individual academic programs may require specific courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum as prerequisites for certain major requirements.</u> Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.
- Students meet the Writing Proficiency Requirement by completing two upper-level Writing Intensive courses in their major or courses designed for their degree program. Contact the Academic Advisor for additional information or questions.
- Residence is satisfied only by official enrollment in and completion of course work applied toward the degree requirements.
 - A minimum of 30 semester hours of work counted toward the degree must be completed with Tarleton. The work completed at Tarleton and counted toward the degree must include at least 24 advanced hours (3000 or 4000 level) and 12 of these advanced hours must be in the major subject.

- How does duplicating a course impact my GPA?
 - A student may take a course a second or subsequent time at the same institution. The highest grade will be included in the GPA calculation.
- Can I take a course at another school and transfer it back to TSU?
 - o If you plan to take a course at another school and transfer it back to TSU, you need to meet with both an advisor and Transfer Services. An advisor can tell you the correct course number to take and assist with completion of a Concurrent Enrollment Form if needed.
