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Degree Specific

- This 8 semester evaluation is contingent on the successful completion of each class. Please note this evaluation is designed with <u>prerequisites and course rotation in mind.</u>
- Environmental & Society Requirement (one course, 3 hours): COMM 3305, PHIL 4305,
- GEOL 4311, EASC 3370, ENVS 3375, 3323, POLS 4310*, ECON 3304, SOCI 3312, WSES 4306, or 3315.
- Life Science Elective (one course, 2 hours): SOIL 4212, BIOL 3340, 3407, 3415, WSES 3309, 3313, 3404, 4303, 4309*, 4311.
- Physical Science Elective (two courses, 5 hours): ENVS 3302, SOIL 3412, 4212, 4450, BIOL 4441, CHEM 4477, EASC 3340, 3350, or GEOL 3310.
- Advanced Electives (4 hours) consist of any advanced course with the following prefixes: WSES, ENVS, EASC, CHEM, GEOG, GEOL.
- It is recommended that students take EASC 3360 in the second semester fo their third year. Students may choose from all other options in the first semester of their fourth year.

Degree Information

- Texas Common Course Numbering System (TCCNS) provides a statewide shared, uniform set of course designations to use in determining course equivalency and degree applicability of transfer credit.
 - This four-year degree plan provides a model for on-time degree completion using as many TCCNS courses as possible. The plan also shows the first point when no TCCNS options are
- available for this degree. See the current Undergraduate Catalog for course prerequisites.
 Course availability at TSU is subject to change, and the plan may change based on updates to TSU's course offerings.
 - Individual academic programs may require specific courses contained in parts of the
- University Core Curriculum as prerequisites for certain major requirements. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.
- Students meet the Writing Proficiency Requirement by completing two upper-level Writing Intensive courses in their major or courses designed for their degree program. Contact the Academic Advisor for additional information or questions.
- Residence is satisfied only by official enrollment in and completion of course work applied toward the degree requirements.
 - A minimum of 30 semester hours of work counted toward the degree must be completed with Tarleton. The work completed at Tarleton and counted toward the degree must include at least 24 advanced hours (3000 or 4000 level) and 12 of these advanced hours must be in the major subject.
- A student may take a course a second or subsequent time at the same institution. The highest grade will be included in the GPA calculation.
- If you plan to take a course at another school and transfer it back to TSU, you need to meet
 with both an advisor and Transfer Services. An advisor can tell you the correct course number to take and assist with completion of a Concurrent Enrollment Form if needed.
