This 8 semester evaluation is contingent on the successful completion of each class. Please note this evaluation is designed with **prerequisites in mind**.

1) Approved Prior Learning Credit:

- **Must be related to subject matter taught in Child and Family Studies.
- **Must be documented (transcripts, certificate of completion, employer training records, etc.).
- ** Must equate 12 to 33 semester credit hour equivalents.
- ** The total Occupational Specialization credit hours MUST equate to a minimum of 33 semester credit
- hour equivalents in order to be eligible for the BAAS degree. All 33 credit hours may come from technical training (non-transferable coursework, continuing education, military schools, work experience etc.). All training must be approved by the BAAS Committee for credit.
 - ** Each prospective BAAS student is evaluated individually to determine eligibility for the degree program. Various community college child development-related courses may be used as part of the Occupational Specialization. Please see the Tarleton State University College of Education CHFS BAAS
- 2)Approved Elective Credit: The number of approved, required, electives depends on the number of credits awarded for the Prior Learning Credit, Technical Training, and/or Approved Work Experience.
 The combined credit hours for the degree must total 120 credit hours minimum.

Degree Information

- Texas Common Course Numbering System (TCCNS) provides a shared, uniform set of course
- designations for students and their advisors to use in determining both course equivalency and degree applicability of transfer credit on a statewide basis.
 - This 120 hour four-year degree plan provides a model for on-time completion of this TSU program using as many TCCNS courses as possible. The four-year plan also shows the first point when no
- TCCNS options are available for this program. See the current Undergraduate Catalog for courseprerequisites. Course availability at TSU is subject to change, and the plan may change based on updates to TSU's course offerings.
- Individual academic programs may require specific courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum as prerequisites for certain major requirements. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.
- Students meet the Writing Proficiency Requirement by completing two upper-level Writing Intensive courses in their major or courses designed for their degree program. Contact the Academic Advisor for additional information or questions.
- Residence is satisfied only by official enrollment in and completion of course work applied toward the degree requirements.

A minimum of 30 semester hours of work counted toward the degree must be completed with Tarleton. The work completed at Tarleton and counted toward the degree must include at least 24 advanced hours (3000 or 4000 level) and 12 of these advanced hours must be in the major subject.

- A minimum of 45 advanced credits (3000/4000 level course work) are required and needed to satisfy degree requirements.
- How does duplicating a course impact my GPA?
 - A student may take a course a second or subsequent time at the same institution. The highest grade will be included in the GPA calculation.
- Can I take a course at another school and transfer it back to TSU?
 - If you plan to take a course at another school and transfer it back to TSU, you .need to meet with both an advisor and Transfer Services. An advisor can tell you the correct course number to take and assist with completion of a Concurrent Enrollment Form if needed.
