## **Degree Specific**

- This 8 semester evaluation is contingent on the successful completion of each class. Please note this evaluation is designed with **prerequisites and course rotation in mind.**
- As part of the screening process for incoming candidates, students are required to successfully take Write placer and participate in an interview process. Please see academic advisor for guidance.
- A **2.75 GPA overall** and in *each* of the notated areas is required for admission and must be maintained for program continuation and certification.
- Completion of at least 12 hours in Certification Area; 15 hours if Math or Science is required for admission to the Educator Preparation Program.
- Student is to complete an English Literature course to fulfill the TSU Core: Language, Philosophy, & Culture requirement.
- **No grade lower than a "C"** in Mathematics, Professional Education, Certification Area, Reading and the 9 hours of required English. A grade of **"B"** or better is required for COMM.
- Students should complete their application to the Educator Preparation Program the semester in which they are enrolled in EDUC 3320.
- **EDSP 4362** Summer only, **EDSP 4363** and **EDSP 4364** Fall only, and **EDSP 4365** Spring only.
- CHEM 1405 can be an exception for CHEM 1302
- GEOL 1403 can be an exception for PHYS 1302
- SPAN 1411 or SPAN 1300 can be an exception for SPAN 1303
- BIOL 1408 can be an exception for BIOL 2310
- GEOL 1401, PHYS 1404, or PHYS 1405 can be an exception for EASC 2310
- TECA 1303 can be an exception for EASC 2310
- TECA 1354 can be an exception for PSYC 2308, PSYC 3303, or CHFS 3300
- EDUC 2301 can be an exception for EDSP 3361
- GEOG 1300, GEOG 1301, or GEOG 1302 can be an exception for GEOG 1303

## **Degree Information**

- This 120 hour four-year degree plan provides a model for on-time completion of this TSU program using as many TCCNS courses as possible. The four-year plan also shows the first point when no TCCNS options are available for this program. See the current Undergraduate Catalog for course prerequisites. Course availability at TSU is subject to change, and the plan shown below may change based on updates to TSU's course offerings.
- Texas Common Course Numbering System (TCCNS) provides a shared, uniform set of course designations for students and their advisors to use in determining both course equivalency and degree applicability of transfer credit on a statewide basis.
- **Individual academic programs may require specific courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum as prerequisites for certain major requirements.** Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.
- Students meet the Writing Proficiency Requirement by completing two upper-level Writing Intensive courses in their major or courses designed for their degree program. Contact the Academic Advisor for additional information or questions.
- Residence is satisfied only by official enrollment in and completion of course work applied toward the degree requirements.
  - A minimum of 30 semester hours of work counted toward the degree must be completed with Tarleton. The work completed at Tarleton and counted toward the degree must include at least 24 advanced hours (3000 or 4000 level) and 12 of these advanced hours must be in the major subject.
- How does duplicating a course impact my GPA?
  - A student may take a course a second or subsequent time at the same institution. The highest grade will be included in the GPA calculation.
- Can I take a course at another school and transfer it back to TSU?
  - If you plan to take a course at another school and transfer it back to TSU, you need to meet with both an advisor and Transfer Services. An advisor can tell you the correct course number to take and assist with completion of a Concurrent Enrollment Form if needed.
